

BULLION COIN INVOICE

In 2013 the State of Minnesota passed a law regulating bullion coin dealers, HF157/80G.

This law redefines bullion coins as any coin with 1% or more precious metal content.

The State of Minnesota now defines silver, silvered, billon or gold ancient coins as "bullion" coins:

1.10 Bullion coin. "Bullion coin" means any coin containing more than one percent by weight of silver, gold, platinum, or other precious metal."

Because of this redefinition, the State of Minnesota now considers Ancient Imports a "bullion coin dealer" and I'm required by state law to report specific information related to the bullion coin(s) you have purchased.

The following is the information that the State of Minnesota requires me to report on your bullion coin(s).

** As a general rule most coin orders are shipped either the same day as ordered, or the next day. If we are out of town at a coin show or on vacation we ship orders the day after we return. Orders are delivered within 1-5 days in the US. A few take a bit longer but this is the exception, not the rule. International coin orders generally arrive in 5-20 days. A few take as much as 7-10 weeks but this is the exception, not the rule*

*** I am unable to calculate the actual or exact precious metal content for your coin(s). Ancient coins were not struck to a standardized purity like modern coins. This is why the total bullion content for your coin(s) listed above is designated as UNKNOWN. I am striving to comply with a law that the State of Minnesota passed with modern coins in mind. I have given 100% effort to comply with this law and my goal is to be as accurate as historically possible. In addition, the value of your coin(s) is not based on its precious metal content; it is based on its collectability as a historical object. I make no claim as to the material aspects of the bullion coin(s) you are purchasing. I make no claims as to the bullion coin's performance, efficacy, nature, investment value, central characteristics, liquidity, earnings potential, or profitability. I price my coins based on sales history for similar coins, I do not take into account the value of the precious metal contained in the coin. I never run "marketing programs" to sell multiple historical coins based on a single representative picture. Each coin purchased will be the actual coin as pictured on my website.*
